

CARROLL COUNTY ORDINANCE #8
An Ordinance Regulating Going-Out-of-Business Sales,
Established Permit Fees and Other Matters

Prior to conducting a going-out-of-business sale for a non-farm business, every person, firm or corporation shall obtain a permit at a fee of \$50.00.

The permit or accurate reproduction of the permit shall be clearly and conspicuously posted at all entrances to the site of the sale and at all locations where sales are consummated.

Additional merchandise shall not be added to the merchandise of the liquidating business for the purposes of the sale.

To the extent not in conflict herewith, Iowa Code section 714.16 is incorporated herein by this reference.

The going-out-of-business sale shall not exceed 120 days in length.

Going-out-of-business sale permits may be obtained from the County Building Permit official.

A violation of this ordinance shall be a County infraction and the provisions of Iowa Code Section 331.307 are incorporated herein by this reference.

The ordinance adopted December 10, 1990, concerning going-out-of-business sales is hereby repealed.
