

**CARROLL COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 10**

**E-911 Address and Street Sign Protection**

- 1.0 TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the E-911 Address and Street Sign Protection Ordinance.
- 2.0 VIOLATION. Any person who willfully and intentionally, without lawful authority, attempts to move or moves an address sign, address sign post, street sign or street sign post erected under plans approved by the E-911 Service Board, shall be punished as provided for in this ordinance.
- 3.0 PENALTY. Each day of the existence of a condition in violation of this ordinance and each act shall be a separate county infraction as provided for in Iowa Code Section 331.307 and punished by a civil penalty not in excess of one hundred dollars for the first violation, or not to exceed two hundred dollars for each repeat offense. Any person, firm, corporation, partnership, or other legal entity who violates, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with this ordinance or establishes, suffers or permits a prohibited act shall be punished accordingly.
- 4.0 OTHER LAWS. Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent a person from also being arrested and charged with an applicable criminal violation under state law if such a charge is deemed appropriate by the County Attorney, County Sheriff, or other law enforcement officer.
- 5.0 REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. When any ordinance repealing a former ordinance, clause, or provision is repealed, the repeal shall not be construed to revive the former ordinance, clause or provision, unless it is specifically stated.
- 6.0 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason, any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- 7.0 EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be full force and effect after is passage, approval, and publications as provided by law.
