

**CARROLL COUNTY, IOWA
ORDINANCE NO. 36**

AN ORDINANCE of the County of Carroll, Iowa, providing for requirements concerning room and board fees of the Sheriff as authorized by Iowa Code Section 356.7.

WHEREAS The Carroll County Board of Supervisors finds that the cost of room and board for prisoners in the county jail exceeds \$48.00 per day. Therefore the following is adopted:

Section 1 The Ordinances of the County of Carroll, Iowa, are amended by adopting a new provision in which is:

The County Sheriff shall charge a fee of \$2.00 per hour for a prisoner who is eighteen years of age or older and who has been convicted of a criminal offense or sentenced for contempt of court for violation of a domestic abuse order for room and board provided to the prisoner while in the custody of the County Sheriff.

Section 2. **REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. **WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
